◆ BIRD ADOPTION PROGRAM

1. OBJECTIVES: To take in unwanted, neglected, found or mistreated birds, provide medical care when deemed necessary. By application find such birds a caring stable home.
2. COMMITTEE: Will be comprised of five persons
 - A. The Chairperson who will be appointed by the President.
 - B. Four committee members with possible alternates will be chosen by the chairperson.
 - C. Positions will be reviewed annually.
3. INTAKE & EVALUATION:

For medical reasons all incoming birds will be quarantined for no less than 30 days. During this quarantine period each bird will be evaluate to determine the type of home required and if medical treatment is necessary.
4. OUTGOING & ADOPTIONS:

By process of application we will foster/adopt out all birds to caring homes.

 - A: We will list available birds each month in the newsletter and accept applications on the listed birds.
 - B: The Bird Adoption Committee will meet as necessary to review applications.
 - C: During the adoption process, if needed, we will request a home visit and interview with the applicant. Home visits are usually required when the person applying for adoption is unknown to the committee members.
5. COMPANIONS: The emotional needs of the bird being fostered/adopted, are to be met through companionship, either human or species. All feathered friends going home become lifelong companions, therefore, we will insist that the bird be returned to the Bird Adoption Program for re-adoption.
